Local jobs

The Wak Wak Solar Farm project is expected to generate up to 900 local jobs during construction, and up to 50 jobs during the up to 30 years of operation. The proposed project will not only create direct employment opportunities during construction, but also through increased demand for local products, materials, and services.
